# Norms and standards for the bachelor of physical education programme leading to bachelor of physical education degree (B.P.Ed.).

#### **VISION:**

The University strives towards excellence in teaching – learning with relevant curriculum and innovative research, promoting good governance and inclusiveness by providing leadership for a knowledge society.

#### **MISSION:**

- 1. To design and teach curriculum that is contemporary, competitive and content-rich to make students creative, knowledgeable and entrepreneurial.
- 2. To encourage faculty to engage in relevant and globally competitive inter multidisciplinary research, consultancy and extension work.
- 3. To provide infrastructure resources to facilitate access, equity and harmony both for students and faculty.
- 4. To create the best possible academic ambience for achieving advancement of students and faculty to be leader in their endeavors.

#### 1. PREAMBLE:

The Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed.) Programme is a professional Programme <u>meant</u> for preparing teachers for Physical Education in class VI-X and for conducting Physical Education and Sports activities in classes XI-XII.

## **REGULATIONS**

#### 2. DURATION AND WORKING DAYS.

#### 2.1 **DURATION**:

The B.P.Ed. Programme shall be of duration of two academic years, consisting of four semesters. However, the student shall be permitted to complete the programme within a maximum of Four years from the date of admission to the programme.

#### **2.2** WORKING DAYS:

There shall be at least 200 working days per year exclusive of admission and examination etc. The institution shall work for a minimum of 36 hours in a week (Five or Six days a week).

#### 3. INTAKE, ELIGIBILITY AND ADMISSION PROCEDURE.

#### 3.1 **INTAKE**:

There Shall be a basic unit of 100 (One hundred) Students with two Section of 50 (Fifty) each OR Approval by the NCTE  $\!\!\!/$  State Government and the University.

#### 3.1 ELIGIBILITY:

Any graduate of Karnatak University or of any other University recognized by the Karnatak University and satisfies any of the following conditions will be eligible for admission to B.P.Ed. degree course.

a) Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 45% marks and having at least Participation in the Inter – Collegiate / Inter – Zonal/ District / School Competition in Sports and Games as recognized by the University / Govt. of Karnataka / Govt. of India/ State Govt. / SGM.

or

b) Bachelor's degree in Physical Education with 45% marks.

or

c) Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 45% marks and studied Physical Education as Compulsory/ Elective / Optional Subject.

d) Bachelor's degree with 45% marks and having participated in Internal National/ Inter- University/ State Competitions or Secured 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> Position in sports and Games. Recognized by respective federation / AFU/ IOA/ SCFI/ Govt. of India.

or

e) Graduation with 45% marks and at least three years of teaching experience ( for deputed in service candidates i.e. trained Physical Education teachers/ coaches / Physical Education Personals.

or

f) Graduate with at least 45% marks, possessing N.C.C. 'C' certificate or passed basic course in adventure sports, one year training programme in sports science, sports management, sports coaching, yoga, Olympic education, sports journalism, certificate/diploma course in physical education

The relaxation in the percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and the reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC and other Categories shall be as per the rules of the central Government) State Government which ever is applicable.

#### 3.2 ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

Admission shall be made on merit on the basis of marks obtend by the Sports Proficiency test Physical fitness test and marks obtained in the qualifying examination or any other selections process as per the policy of the University / State Government.

#### 3.3 NOT ELIGIBLE FOR ANY TYPE OF PHYSICAL DISABILITY CANDIDATES.

#### 3.4 SELECTION PROCEDURE:

Candidates seeking admission shall be awarded points/marks as follows:

#### A. Academic Performance

50% of the percentage of marks scored at the degree examination (e.g. Marks

Scored at the degree 70% x 0.5=65.00 points)

#### B. Physical Fitness (N.P.F.P.)

Physical fitness will be cored for 50 mars (annexure 1 & 2) and reduced to 20

Points (e.g. out of 50 points scored  $40 \times 0.4 - 16.00$ )

#### C. Proficiency in any 2 games

Skill proficiency in any two major games of candidates choice is to be evaluated for 5 marks each (2x5-10)

#### D. Sports Achievement

Points for achievement in sports are to be awarded as follows:-

#### a. National participation representing state (Inter-State)

1<sup>st</sup> Place 20 marks 3<sup>rd</sup> Place 10 marks

2<sup>nd</sup> Place 15 marks Participation 07 marks

**Bonus:** 5 bonus points for each additional representation limited to maximum

15 marks. The total points shall not exceed.

#### **b.** Inter-University Participation (All-India or Zonal)

1<sup>st</sup> Place 10 marks 3<sup>rd</sup> Place 05 marks

2<sup>nd</sup> Place 07 marks Participation 03 marks

Bonus: 3 bonus points for each additional representation limited to maximum

09 marks.

#### **C.** University participation (University Inter-collegiate)

1<sup>st</sup> Place 05 marks 3<sup>rd</sup> Place 02 marks

2<sup>nd</sup> Place 03 marks Participation 01 marks

**Bonus:** 1 bonus points for each additional representation limited to maximum 05 marks.

**Note: 1.** Participation in recognized tournament organized by IUSB or the University or in a tournament / meet recognized by the State Association / Federation in any discipline at one (highest) level shall be considered

### 3.4 **Medical and Physical Fitness:**

Candidate shall be medically fit for the rigors of the trainings involved in B.P.Ed. To be certified by Government Medical Officer not below the rank of Assistant Surgeon.

#### 4. **MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION:**

The medium of instruction shall be Kannada or English.

#### 5. **ATTENDANCE:**

Each Semester shall be taken as a unit for purpose of calculating attendance.

- 5.1 A student shall have to attendance less than 80% of all Lecturers, tutorials, Practical's
- 5.2 Shortage of attendance to the extent of 10% maybe condoned by the Vice-Chancellor on the recommend arrival the institution Concerned.
