ORDER

WHEREAS, The Rajeev Gandhi Education Society, Ron, Gadaga District, Karnataka had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition to R.G.E Society's B.P.Ed College, Rajiv Gandhi Education Society, Ayurvedic Medical College Campus, Ron-582209, Gadag District, Karnatak for (B.P.Ed) course of one year duration with an annual intake of 50 students and was granted recognition vide order No. SRO/NCTE/B.P.Ed./2005-2006/4798 dated 21.12.2005.

2. AND WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (73 of 1993) and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulation, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education notified the Regulation, 2014 on 01.12.2014. On 28.01.2015, an affidavit from institution was received regarding compliance of revised norms as per Regulations, 2014. The revised order was issued to the institution on 20.05.2015 with one basic unit of 100 students. On 30.07.2015, a letter was received by this office from the institution.

3. AND WHEREAS the Southern Regional committee in its 316<sup>th</sup> meeting held during 07<sup>th</sup> & 08<sup>th</sup> July, 2016 considered the matter and decided to issue show cause notice.

1. The land is shown in EC as 'mortgaged'.
2. BPEd, B.Ed (1 unit) and, D.El.Ed are in reference. It is not clear whether B.Ed and D.El.Ed are also to be shifted.

4. AND WHEREAS as per the decision of SRC, a show Cause Notice issued to the institution on 29.07.2016. The institution submitted reply to the Show cause notice on 31.08.2016.

5. AND WHEREAS the SRC in its 324<sup>th</sup> meeting held during 07<sup>th</sup> & 08<sup>th</sup> December 2016 considered the show cause notice reply and decided as under -

1. "Land is mortgaged.
2. As per the Building Completion Certificate the built-up area is not adequate even for B.Ed (2 units) and D.El.Ed (1 unit)."

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6. **AND WHEREAS** as per the decision of SRC, a withdrawal order was issued to the institution vide order No: F SRO/NCTE/APS01914/B.P Ed/KA/2016-17/90760 dated 17.12.2016. Aggrieved by the withdrawal order of SRC, the institution has preferred an appeal before the appellate authority, NCTE Hqrs.

7. **AND WHEREAS** the appellate authority vide order F No 89-130/2017 Appeal/9<sup>th</sup> Meeting-2017/55032 dated 21.06.2017 remanded back the case for necessary action as indicted in the order.

8. **AND WHEREAS** the SRC in its 343<sup>rd</sup> meeting considered the appeal order and decided as under:

1. Appellate Authority's order is noted.
2. Our withdrawal order has been stayed.
3. Organize VT inspection after collecting fees if not already done.
4. Ask the VT to collect all documents

9. **AND WHEREAS** as per the decision of SRC a letter was issued to the institution on 09.09.2017. On 22.08.2017 the institution submitted its reply.

10. **AND WHEREAS** on 29.09.17 the institution has submitted inspection fees of Rs 150000/- Vide No-376673, dated 21.09.2017. The inspection of the institution was conducted on 24.02.2018, and the VT report along with documents received on 06.04.2018.

11. **AND WHEREAS** the above matter was considered by SRC in its 361<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 21<sup>st</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> June, 2018 and it was decided as under -

1. The Appellate Authority has directed us to collect all the documents now given by the applicant and process the case according to NCTE Regulations
2. Meanwhile, the file has been requisitioned by the NCTE (HQ)
3. In the absence of the file, we can not take any further action.
4. Let us wait for NCTE (HQ) to return our file.

12. **AND WHEREAS** the above matter was considered by SRC in its 366<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 03<sup>rd</sup> & 04<sup>th</sup> December, 2018 and it was decided as under -

1. We had withdrawn recognition on two grounds – land is mortgaged, built-up area is not adequate
- 2.1 They have filed an EC to show that on 15.02.17 there was no encumbrance
- 2.2 It is strange that the search period was limited to 2 days: 13-15 Feb – 2017
- 2.3 Obtain the latest EC.
- 3.1 Built up area available is (2393+3738) = 6131 sq.mts. This is more than what is required (2000+1500+1500) = 5000 sq.mts
- 3.2 The BP and BCC are in order. But, it should be noted that the BP permits a built-up area of only 2393 sq.mts.
- 3.3 They should explain. Or, preferably, furnish a revised BP.

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- 3.4 Three programmes – B.Ed / D.El.Ed / B.P. Ed are being run in the same premises. The BP and BCC should clearly earmark the lands & buildings for each course
4. They have not filed the Affidavit Certifying accuracy of the information/documents furnished.
5. FDRs are not in order. FDRs are required in original, in joint account with a 5 year validity and @ 12 lakhs per programme.
6. They should file a copy of the title deed certified by the Sub-Registrar.

13. **AND WHEREAS** as per the decision of SRC, a letter issued to the institution on 10.12.2018. The Institution has submitted reply dated 27.12.2018.

14. **AND WHEREAS** the above matter was considered by SRC in its 370<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 07<sup>th</sup> -08<sup>th</sup> February, 2019 and it was decided as under:-

1. This is RPRO case involving B.P.Ed (1 Units) + B.Ed (1 Units) + D.El.Ed (1 Units)
2. The title deed is in regional language and is not legible. They should give a copy certified by the Sub- Registrar along with an English version
3. The title deed is reported to cover 10.25 acres but, the BCC's refer only to 5.85 acres. They should show that 5 acres are clearly demarcated for B.P.Ed
- 4.1 The built-up area is adequate
- 4.2 The Land area is adequate
5. The new EC submitted clearly show that the mortgage has been redeemed
6. Issue SCN for submission of a fresh copy of title deed certified by the Sub-Registrar along with an English Version and for proof of earmarking 5 acres of land for B.P.Ed

15. **AND WHEREAS** as per the decision of SRC, a Show Cause Notice issued to the institution on 15.02.2019. The Institution has submitted reply dated 25.02.2019 received in office 05.03.2019.

16. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was finally considered by the SRC in its 375<sup>th</sup> meeting held from 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup> May 2019 decided as under:-

*The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-*

*The matter was considered by the Committee and it was decided to issue order for continuance of recognition to run B.P.Ed with an annual intake of 100 (1 unit) subject to submission of FDRs of Rs 7 lakh and 5 lakh, totalling Rs 12 lakh towards Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund into joint account for a duration of 5 years.*

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*After receipts of the original FDRs, necessary orders (final recognition) be issued*

17. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution **R.G.E Society's College of Physical Education, Survey No. 681/2, Town Panchayat: Ron, Tah: Ron, Gadag District, Karnataka 582 209** run by **The Rajeev Gandhi Education Society, Ron, Gadaga District, Karnataka** for continuation of conducting B.P Ed course of two years duration with an intake of 100 students (one unit) subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
  - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
  - III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation form the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
  - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
6. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc as applicable.
7. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
8. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution: its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake, available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities, instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-
- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution.
  - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
  - c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter.
  - d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
  - e. Fee charged from students,
  - f. Available infrastructural facilities,
  - g. Facilities added during the last quarter.

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- h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
  - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application;
  - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires;
  - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
9. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
10. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
11. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued thereunder, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
